Dr. Francesco Tramutola completed his master degree in Chemistry in 2007 at the University of Basilicata. Thesis: "Synthesis of new potential HIV-1 Protease Inhibitors". Tutors: Prof. Carlo Bonini e Prof. Maria Funicello.

In 2006 he worked three months as a Socrates-Erasmus undergraduate visiting student in the laboratory of Prof. Françoise Colobert at ECPM in Strasbourg.

In 2008 he attended a ten months internship in the laboratories of Medicinal Chemistry at GlaxoSmithKline in Verona, under the supervision of Dr. David Amantini.

In 2010 he joined, for six months, Prof. Fu's group at MIT in Boston as a graduate visiting student.

In 2012 he earned his PhD in Chemistry at the University of Basilicata. Thesis: "Synthesis of new peptidomimetic compounds with anti-HIV protease activity". Tutor: Prof. Maria Funicello.

In 2012 he obtained a four months research fellowship granted by ICB-CNR in Rome.

In 2013 he was postdoctoral research associate for one year at the Department of Science-University of Basilicata.

Since 2012 he is Adjunct Professor of Chemistry at the School of Engineering-University of Basilicata.

He is author of seven publications. His research interests concern organic synthesis and metal catalyzed reactions.
