Expert on the subject of "Architecture Design and Survey" (ICAR/17), he conducts research on the abandoned centers and structures.

Scientific interest is addressed at the fundamental technical aspects of the documentation of historic building heritage, with particular reference to the analysis of the historical-critical built, to the examination of documentary sources for the understanding of the settlement dynamics and the evolution of the territory and construction of centers and architectural works, and to the study of iconographic evidence of the past. Played periods of study, development and research in Italy and abroad on advanced techniques of representation, collaboration with institutions for studies and exhibitions on particular architectural episodes of Lucania, and he won a scholarship for research on photo modeling for the return of archaeological evidence at the Department of Civil Engineering of the University of Salerno. He is the author of several scientific papers presented in national and international conferences on issues of documentation of the architectural heritage, and the monograph «Reading the historical criticism of a ghost town. The utopian project of Campomaggiore» (Cues 2013).
